Highland Quilt One

Requirements

|-----------------------------|--|
| 1. Panel FF180-1A, FF180-1B | One double panel of each (approx. 24" of each) |
| 2. Thistles FF181-1 | 1/2 yard – 45cm |
| 3. Circles FF182-1 | 1/2 yard – 45cm plus 3 yards for backing |
| 4. Feathers FF183-1 | 1/2 yard – 45cm plus 1/2 yard for binding |
| 5. Tartan FF184-1 | 1/2 yard – 45cm |
| 6. Highland Animals FF185-1 | 1 yard |

Cutting

From fabric 1 trim both the double panels to 20.1/2" by 40.1/2"

From fabric 2 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 3 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 4 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 5 cut forty eight rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 6 cut 3.1/2" wide strips: two at 48.1/2", two at 54.1/2"

For the backing cut one 58" length of fabric 3 across the width of fabric, plus two 16" lengths of fabric 3 across the width of fabric

For the binding cut seven 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 4 across the width of fabric.

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.

Sewing



Sew together one rectangle each from fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 to make a 4.1/2" square.

Make forty four of these quilt blocks.

Sew the blocks together in two strips of ten blocks and two strips of twelve blocks. Alternate the blocks across these strips so that in one block the stripes are horizontal while in the next block they are vertical.

Begin and end the two smaller strips with vertical stripes.

Begin and end the two longer strips with horizontal stripes.

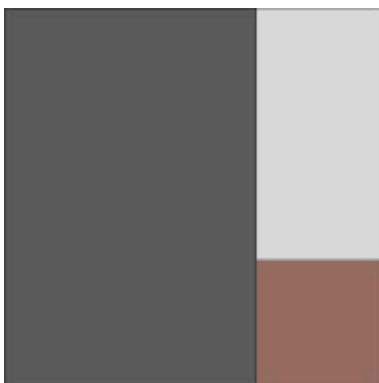
Assembling the Highland quilt

Sew the two shorter lengths to the top and bottom of the quilt panel. Sew the two longer lengths to the sides.

Sew the two 48.1/2" lengths of fabric 6 to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Sew the two 54.1/2" lengths of fabric 6 to the sides of the quilt.

For the backing fabric you will need 58" squares of both backing fabric and wadding.



For the backing fabric, sew the two 16" lengths of fabric 3 together along one short side. This will give you a panel 16" wide by 84" long. Cut this to 58" long. Sew this panel to the 58" strip of fabric along the 58" edge.

For the binding, sew the seven strips of fabric 4 together to give one very long strip to make the binding with.

| 2. Thistles FF181-2 | 1/2 yard – 45cm |
| 3. Circles FF182-2 | 1/2 yard – 45cm plus 3 yards for backing |
| 4. Feathers FF183-2 | 1/2 yard – 45cm plus 1/2 yard for binding |
| 5. Tartan FF184-2 | 1/2 yard – 45cm |
| 6. Highland Animals FF185-2 | 1 yard |

Cutting

From fabric 1 trim both panels to 20.1/2" by 40.1/2"

From fabric 2 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 3 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 4 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 5 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 6 cut 3.1/2" wide strips: two at 48.1/2", two at 54.1/2"

For the backing cut one 58" length of fabric 3 across the width of fabric, plus two 16" lengths of fabric 3 across the width of fabric

For the binding cut seven 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 4 across the width of fabric.

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.

Sewing



Sew together one rectangle each from fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 to make a 4.1/2" square.

Make forty four of these quilt blocks.

Sew the blocks together in two strips of ten blocks and two strips of twelve blocks. Alternate the blocks across these strips so that in one block the stripes are horizontal while in the next block they are vertical.

Begin and end the two smaller strips with vertical stripes.

Begin and end the two longer strips with horizontal stripes.

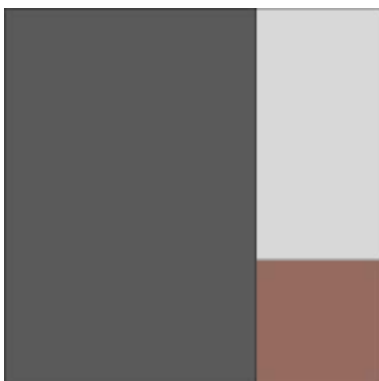
Assembling the Highland quilt

Sew the two shorter lengths to the top and bottom of the quilt panel. Sew the two longer lengths to the sides.

Sew the two 48.1/2" lengths of fabric 6 to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Sew the two 54.1/2" lengths of fabric 6 to the sides of the quilt.

For the backing fabric you will need 58" squares of both backing fabric and wadding.



For the backing fabric, sew the two 16" lengths of fabric 3 together along one short side. This will give you a panel 16" wide by 84" long. Cut this to 58" long. Sew this panel to the 58" strip of fabric along the 58" edge.

For the binding, sew the seven strips of fabric 4 together to give one very long strip to make the binding with.

| 2. Thistles FF181-3 | 1/2 yard – 45cm |
| 3. Circles FF182-3 | 1/2 yard – 45cm plus 3 yards for backing |
| 4. Feathers FF183-3 | 1/2 yard – 45cm plus 1/2 yard for binding |
| 5. Tartan FF184-3 | 1/2 yard – 45cm |
| 6. Highland Animals FF185-3 | 1 yard |

Cutting

From fabric 1 trim both panels to 20.1/2" by 40.1/2"

From fabric 2 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 3 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 4 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 5 cut forty four rectangles 1.1/2" by 4.1/2"

From fabric 6 cut 3.1/2" wide strips: two at 48.1/2", two at 54.1/2"

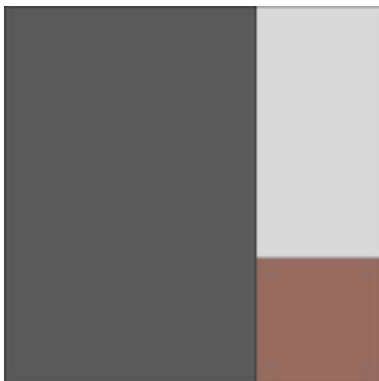
